3. Discussion and consideration of the City Commission Authorizing the City Manager Ron Duncan and Police Chief David Hullum to purchase a used police vehicle from <u>copcarsonline</u>, 12600 B Belcher Rd S, Largo, Florida 33773.

Police Chief David Hullum told the Commissioners that one of the Police Vehicles, a Chevrolet Tahoe, had recently been totalled in an accident. The City received \$15,000 from the insurance. Chief Hullum stated with that amount of money in mind, he plans to put his vehicle into the patrol fleet and find another used police vehicle for his use. He found a 2011 Ford Crown Victoria with 29,634 mile in excellent condition for the sum of \$13,500 which includes shipping. The remainder of the insurance funds will be used for installation of equipment into this vehicle. Chief Hullum believes that this is a good option for us to take at this time.

4. Discussion and Consideration to Approve 2020 RAMP Agreement, TX DoT Project Number M2023ESTL

City Manager Ron Duncan explained that this is the standard agreement that we have had since 2016. RAMP is **R**outine **A**irport **M**aintenance **P**rogram. It allows the Texas Department of Transportation to reimburse the city 50% of its maintenance and repairs up to \$50,000. He stated it is a very good program for small community airports to utilize.
