I. Meeting Called to Order

Terry Slavens called the meeting to order at 12:14 p.m.

II. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

IV. Approve Minutes of the September 26 & October 3, 2018 Meeting

2. Assign Board Members for Grant Quarterly Reports

3. Discuss and Consider Updates to Historic Grant Application and Timeline

Terry Simmons suggests that a revision to the application be made to include more specific information about what the improvements will look like. Upon beginning the project, if major changes have to be made due to unforeseen problems, these requested changes need to be brought before the board for discussion and approval, if necessary.

Terry Simmons presented a revised Historic Preservation Grant Calendar for discussion and consideration.

Debbie Wharton made a motion, seconded by Rhyne Hobbs to accept the Revisions as presented. Motion carried by a vote of four (4) in favor and none (0) opposed
