## Section 1300. Solid Waste

### Sec. 1300-1 Convenience Center Fees

City of Eastland residents, with a current City of Eastland Utility Bill AND photo identification, are allowed to make 1 (One) pickup truck load drop off per month at no charge. Any additional drop offs will be charged in accordance with Table 1300-1a.

#### Vehicle Tires      **\$5 Fee PER Tire**

Only tires removed from privately owned cars and pickup trucks may be dropped off. NO commercial, farm or heavy equipment tires will be accepted.

Residential customers are allowed to drop a maximum of 4 (FOUR) tires in a calendar year. No commercial retail tire repair/sales business will be allowed to drop off tires.

#### Motor Oil/Filters      **.50 cents per Filter**

Used motor oil and used filters may be dropped at the recycling area of the City Yard located at 400 S. Halbryan St. The filter fee of .50 cents for each used oil filter dropped off will apply.

## Section 1800. Utilities

### Sec. 1800-1 Water Utility Deposit.

Minimum Deposit	\$150
Rental Customers	Customers who lease residential property shall be required to provide an increased deposit, greater than the standard deposit, but no greater than twice the highest monthly bill during the previous 12 months.

### Sec. 1800-2 Water Rates & Fees

#### Monthly charges

(a.) Inside City Limits: There is hereby established the following charges for all consumers and users of the municipal water system, except those more specifically provided for in this article, upon the number of gallons of water used per month as determined by the meter of the system.

For the first 2,000 gallons	\$42.77 Per Unit
All in excess of 2,000 gallons (per 1,000 gallons)	\$5.60

(b.) Outside city limits: The rates as set forth in sections 1800-2.(a) shall have **10 percent** added to the bills of all consumers outside the city limits, and the property served shall be the determining factor (Code of Ordinances Sec. 18-62)

For the first 2,000 gallons	\$47.67 Per Unit
All in excess of 2,000 gallons (per 1,000 gallons)	\$6.13

(c.) User fee: The rates as set forth in Section 1800-2(a) & (b), shall have a user fee as defined in **Sec. 18-61 City water sold at premises with water meters.**

Subsection (b) Residential meters serving two or more dwellings **before** October 1, 2004 and (f) Commercial meters **before** October 1, 2004. The entire monthly charge for the water consumed and registered through the meter shall be billed to the water customer and shall include an additional user fee for each and every additional dwelling, business, factory, mercantile or any combination thereof (mixed use occupancy) served by such meter.

Subsection (d) Residential master meters (apartment complex). The entire monthly charge for the water consumed and registered through a residential master meter will be billed to the water customer and shall include an additional user fee based on eighty percent (80%) of maximum occupancy served by the master meter.

**Sec. 1800-3 Bulk water rates.**

Purchases over 1000 gallons will be charged \$35.00 for the first thousand plus a rate of \$3.00 per each additional one hundred gallons (rounded up to the next hundred).

Note: Multiple loads may be written on one ticket, the total for each load will be noted and each load of water will be billed according to bulk water rate schedule (not total overall usage).

**Sec. 1800-4 Water tap charges.**

**NOTE;** The rates listed above are base rates only. The total cost for a water tap will be based on a visual inspection of the location, the type of street surface, curbs, gutters and sidewalks cuts (if required), state permits and any other services required. Actual charges will be determined by the Director of Public and must be paid in full prior to installation of tap. Prices for taps requiring meters larger than 2" will be determined on a case by case basis.

Monthly Charge Schedules: The schedules of sewer user charges shall be as follows:

Schedule A

*Residential users:* Inside the city limits, single-family residences.

Minimum monthly charge		\$44.08 Per Unit
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Schedule B

*Residential users:* Outside the city limits, including single-family residences, multifamily residences, boarding homes, rooming houses, and apartment houses,

*Commercial users:* Inside and outside of the city limits, including multifamily residences, boarding homes, rooming houses, and apartment houses, hotels, tourist courts, schools, hospitals, churches, commercial laundries, restaurants, service stations, car washes, locker plants and/or slaughter houses, courthouse, funeral homes, office buildings, retail and wholesale establishments, municipal offices, and industrial and manufacturing businesses.

(Reference Sec. 18-145 for additional charges to be assessed outside of city limits for new service or existing service reconnections after March 1, 2004)

**NOTE:** The rate listed above is base rates only. The total cost for a sewer tap will be based on a visual inspection of the location, the type of street surface, curbs, gutters and sidewalks cuts (if required), state permits and any other services required. Actual charges will be determined by the Director of Public and must be paid in full prior to installation of tap.

**Sec. 1800-11 Line extension fees**

The first (50') fifty feet of a line extension is covered with the tap fee. Additional extension footage necessary to complete the connection will be based on a visual inspection of the location, type of street surface, curbs, gutters and sidewalk cuts (if required), state permits and any other services required. Actual charges will be determined by the Director of Public Works and must be paid in full prior to extension work.
