IV. The Board of City Commissioners May Discuss and Take Action on
the Following Agenda Items

1. Discussion and Consideration of Second Reading of Ordinance ~~22-890~~ setting the Tax Rate on All Taxable Property in the City of Eastland for the year 2022 and for the Expenses of the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2023

Commissioner Cecil Funderburgh made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Zac Darr, to approve the Second Reading of Ordinance ~~22-890~~, adopting the Tax Rate of .523057, which is effectively a 1.95 percent increase in the tax rate. Commissioner Darr stated for the record that even though the state calls this a tax rate increase, the average homeowner of a \$100,000 home, will actually pay \$85 less.
